SCRIPT: for consideration of the Best Screenplay Award	2x Behind-the-scenes photos
English subtitles	2x 5-15 Second video clips for trailers (textless clips - no subtitles or titles)

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSIONS: THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 30, 2023 AT 7 PM

SUBMISSION & AWARDS ELIGIBILITY:

- Online submission forms will be sent to the filmmakers 2 weeks before the deadline and must be completed on time with videos and all submission files synced to a Google Drive Folder with a shareable link by November 30, 2023 at 7 PM.
- It is the filmmakers' responsibility to obtain all rights and agreements, including IP, copyright, music, script, filmmaking partnership and acting agreements.
- Film cannot be publicly accessed or screened until it has been screened with Digi60.

- Landscape aspect ratio 16:9

- Max. file size: 1GB
- Video format: .MP4 and .MOV

- Introduce yourself: Name, role in submitted film
- Film Title
- 1 line synopsis
